

# 2024 TDRC Nominated Charities

#### **The Stanley Beau Foundation**

The Stanley Beau Foundation is a charity based in Devon inspired by a very special little boy, Stanley Murphy. Stanley suffered from a rare, life-limiting condition called Tay-Sachs Disease. Stanley sadly died in June 2019 aged just four years old. The charity, founded by Stanleys Mum, supports children with life-limiting illness and their families from a child's diagnosis through illness and beyond.

We will be building Devon's first purpose-built facility offering respite holidays and breaks exclusively to families of seriously ill children and those recently bereaved of their children.

This facility will aim to include a day centre so visits will be available to take part in using the indoor hydro pool, sensory room, gardens and much more.

We believe that no family should have to face the devastating news that their child is seriously ill on their own.

We want to complement existing medical services in the knowledge that sick children and their families need much more than just clinical input to help them through a child's illness.



#### **Non-SWPA Members**

- Enter one of the qualifying classes.
- Register online at www.showingscene.com within 14 days of qualification

- You will be sent Qualifying Cards for the Horses / Ponies registered.

# Veteran Horse Society

First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final:

VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2024

Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

#### VHS Regional Final qualification.

All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. This MUST be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitors' responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Those wishing to join or renew with the Society will need to apply for this before 1st April each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged.

#### Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK, Lincolnshire on 30th August – 1st September 2024. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season 2024.

# RoR Qualifiers 2024

#### April 28th 2024 - Class 32

#### **Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024**

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited.

The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration.

Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the Final. Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 23rd 2024

RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a branded prize to the winner. The winner also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24th August 2024. There is also a voucher for a RoR branded prize for the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification for the RoR Ridden Veteran Series Final at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree in August 2024. Vouchers to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

#### Amateur definition:

The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition, a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:

Engage(d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st, 2023. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season. A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

# RoR Qualifiers 2024

#### April 28th 2024 - Class 46

#### **Tattersalls RoR OPEN In Hand Show Series Qualifier 2024**

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 3yrs and over, fillies, mares and geldings. Horses do not need to be shod to compete in the RoR Open In-Hand class. Horses can be shown in a bitless/In-Hand Bridle. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.

All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The first three go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree, August 24th 2024

RoR rosettes 1st - 4th and a branded prize to the winner. Prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

#### All of our classes are eligible for the Sunshine Tour

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 12th – Sunday 15th September 2024.

The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.0m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, Eventer's Challenge from 50cm through to 90cm.

Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping 1st - 3rd place; Showing & Eventers Challenge 1st - 4th place. Qualification does not pass down the line.

Registration of qualification must be completed within 1 month of competition (sooner for late July shows). Restrictions apply to both horse and competitor's previous winnings and amateur status, please check the website for Terms & Conditions.

# STARS Champion of Champions

Classes: 7,8,9,10,11,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21,22,23,24,26,27,29,30,31,32,33,35, 36,37,38,39,40,42,44,50,51,52

- Qualification will be taken from points accrued over the season which give rise to your champion, Reserve or 2nd Reserve for each relevant section across your year's competition. The first option of representing your club MUST be offered to your Champion of each section. Should they be unable to attend you may offer the place to the Reserve: followed by the 2nd Reserve. Only these exhibitors/animals are eligible for qualification. It will be a condition of Affiliation that you keep a running points totals sheet for each animal/section. This must be brought to STARS by a club representative or submitted to STARS in case of any complaints.
- Any exhibit may compete in more than one section at the Championships providing they meet the criteria above for each section.
- Riders and handlers must be current members of the Club/Clubs they represent. You can represent more than one club.
- Northern Clubs must hold a minimum of 4 shows across the current year from which points can be accrued. Southern shows must hold a minimum of 3 shows from which points will be accrued.
- No change of combination of horse/pony/rider/handler is permitted from that which qualified through their Club. Should any horse/pony be sold before this competition takes place the qualification will be offered to the next eligible exhibit. (Res/2nd Res)
- No horse /pony/rider can compete at STARS if they have qualified HOYS in the current year.
- No horse/pony that has been placed in the top 5 at the RIHS in the current year can compete at STARS. Riders can compete on another horse/pony.
- No professional producers can compete, or any horse or pony that is in production on a professional showing yard. (The definition of a professional producer is as follows: The horse/pony is kept at the producer's yard and has FULL SHOW PRODUCTION, which includes: horse/pony is prepared for the show (bathed, plaited ect) Horse/pony also taken to show. Horse/pony worked in for owner or gives tuition to owner/rider in preparation for the ring, Horse/pony prepared for the ring, Horse/pony is stripped/assistance whilst in the ring)
- PLEASE NOTE: Riding Lessons and clinics with professionals along with full livery on a professional
  yard is ALLOWED. Having help from other people at home and at the shows is allowed, we are only
  stopping horses that are in FULL professional production, every other situation is allowed.
- Social media rules: You must not post or transmit any material which could damage the name or reputation of STARS or its competitors/ organisers. Any person found guilty of this would constitute a breach of STARS rules and could result in the person being banned from STARS and could also result in civil/criminal proceedings being brought against you.
- Any stallions must be ridden/handled by a competent person with a minimum age of 14 years.
- Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors and their grooms. All riders must wear
  correctly fitting headgear to PAS015 (ENS1384 are no longer allowed), or higher, whilst mounted
  anywhere on the Showground. Junior members are also compelled to wear them when competing
  in hand. Grooms must wear suitable hats whilst attending in the ring.
- No horse /pony under 4 years may be ridden on the showground. Competitors must be a minimum of 3 years of age to ride any horse/pony on the showground. Anyone leading a LR pony must be a minimum of 16 years. Riders in LR/FR classes MUST use a snaffle bridle only.
- Ages of horse/pony will be 1st of January in the current year.
- Spurs are permitted for Senior riders only (aged over 18 years).
- Excessive use of whips is forbidden and will result in disqualification. Whips must be of regulation length.

#### TDRC RULES FOR COMPETITORS & SPECTATORS

- All competitors and spectators shall hold the organisers TDRC and the landowners blameless, and indemnify them against any legal proceedings ensuing from any kind of accident, loss or damage to horse/pony, rider, spectator, vehicle, dog or property.
- Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes and with a £10 deposit, refundable if objection upheld.
- The judges' decision is final any competitor or spectator arguing with a judge may be asked to leave the showground and will be banned from the club for the rest of the season.
- It is compulsory for any mounted persons under 18 yrs. to wear a hard hat to current BS; this rule also applies to under 12 yrs. showing in hand. We strongly recommend that body protectors be worn when jumping.
- Any animal the committee deems to be in an unfit state will be asked to leave the show field.
- No cantering or galloping outside the rings or in the lorry park.
- No lunging in the lorry park.
- Competitors must leave the ring at a walk.
- No warming up in showing rings, use warm up areas ONLY.
- Stallions and colts are permitted on the field by prior arrangement but on the understanding that you may be asked to leave by the committee if they are behaving in an unsuitable manner.
- All competitors must be correctly dressed for the classes they are in.
   Competitors will be banned for mistreatment of any animal, no refund will be given.
- All trophies, gala and presentation are held for one season and must be returned by the date labelled on them, and must be returned in good clean condition with professional engraving only. Anyone returning trophies that breach this rule will not be allowed trophies in future.
- All horses & ponies must have their annual vaccinations and passports may be spot checked.
- Any breach of the above rules will invalidate all entries for the remainder of the day, no refund will be given.
- By entering the showfield you are agreeing to these T&C. You are also accepting these T&C for anyone accompanying you to the event.
- In the event of the show being cancelled there will be full refunds. There will be no refunds if you are unable to attend the show. On production of a vet certificate refunds may be issued for that horse/pony


