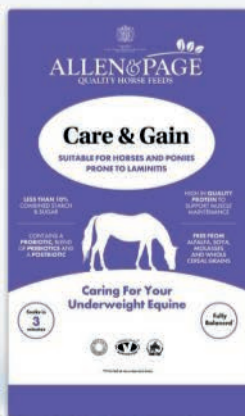

Stars is a Members ONLY qualifier, so to have a chance to qualify you need to be a member of TDRC. The member with the highest number of points in each qualifying class will go forward. However should this member choose not to take the qualifier it can be offered to the reserve and then second reserve. This is a team qualifier that takes place at Aintree Equestrian Centre, Ormskirk Road, Aintree, Liverpool L9 5AS 19th - 22nd November 2026.

Sunshine Tour

These open qualifiers include Show Jumping, Working Hunter, Ridden and Inhand Showing. To qualify for this tour you will need to have been placed 1st-3rd in Show Jumping, and 1st-4th in the other disciplines. You MUST register your qualification within 1 month of the event (sooner for our late July show). Restrictions apply to both horse and competitor's previous winnings and amateur status, please check their website for full Terms and Conditions. Registration and to submit evidence of your results visit www.sunshinetour.co.uk. This event takes place at The All-England Showground Hickstead 17th-20th September 2026.

Veteran Horse Society

This event takes place at Arena UK, Lincolnshire on 4th - 6th September 2026. www.veteran-horse-society.co.uk for all further information.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification. *Those wishing to join or renew the Society will need to apply for this before 1st July each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged.*

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each Area Qualifier class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their card in the ring at all times and have their showing card signed by the judge as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership, this MUST be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitors' responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships,

Arena UK, Lincolnshire 4th – 6th September 2026. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid season in 2026.

UK Ponies & Horses Qualifiers

These shows are a qualifier for the UK Ponies & Horses Spring Classic which will take place in March 2027 at Onley Grounds Equestrian Centre in Warwickshire. The 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed competitors in classes marked ** will qualify.

Competitors are not required to become a member of UK Ponies & Horses to enter the qualifying classes or to compete in the final. Qualification Cards are not handed out in the ring, however qualification will be verified by the UKPH admin once the results from the qualifying show have been received. www.ukponies.uk

NPS Qualifiers

NPS Summer Championships 2026 – 4th – 6th August 2026, held at Three Counties Showground

The Summer Championships are the culmination of the NPS showing year, holding our prestigious finals for which competitors have travelled the country to qualify for. With two impressive Gala Evening Performances held under floodlights with the iconic Malvern Hills in the background, it is a picturesque scene that everyone looks forward to. We are host to some of the most historic finals in the country as well as having big prize money up for grabs in the Ottergayle and Assendons finals. We also have an array of Horse of the Year Show qualifiers for all of the pony classes.

RoR Qualifier Information

Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2026

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 yrs or over on the 1st January 2025. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series.

This series is open to AMATEUR riders ONLY - those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration.

The judge will not ride in the qualifiers but will ride in the final. Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. **The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting. Prizes:** RoR rosettes 1st - 4th plus Tattersalls RoR official merchandise voucher 1st £20, 2nd £10, 3rd £5. Highest placed Veteran (15+) £10. For qualifiers held prior to July 31st 2026, the winner will qualify for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club National Championships on August 22nd 2026. Highest placed Veteran qualifies for the RoR Ridden Veteran Final on the same day.

Amateur definition:

The rules are as in the rule book with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition, a person classed as an amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season. Engage in (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a professional producer's/trainer's yard from January 1st 2025. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a professional/trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a professional producer/trainer at a SHOW in the current season. A rider who has ridden for a professional /producer trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

RoR Qualifier Information

Tattersalls RoR OPEN In Hand Show Series Qualifier 2026

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 3yrs and over, fillies, mares and geldings. Handlers must be 15 yrs or over on the 1st January 2025. Horses do not need to be shod to compete in the RoR Open in hand class. Horses can be shown in bitless/in-hand bridles. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored. All RoR members entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses rules and regulations from time to time in force. Handlers/grooms must wear a current safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. **The first three go forward to the final at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree August 2026.**

Prizes: RoR rosettes 1st-4th + Tattersalls RoR official merchandise vouchers 1st £20, 2nd £10, 3rd £5'

Tattersalls RoR NOVICE Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2026

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, any height, must have raced in GB and have current RoR Competition Membership. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January 2026. Horses will be ridden by the Judge and will be stripped for conformation assessment. Horses to be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited.

All those entering and/or participating in RoR classes agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Competitors/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes are NOT ignored in this series

The first three go forward to the Final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships Aintree, August 22nd, 2026.

Prizes: RoR rosettes 1st –4th plus Tattersalls RoR official merchandise voucher 1st £30, 2nd £20, 3rd £10.

To take part in this class, horses must NOT have won: a ridden open class under any affiliated showing society including (inc SEIB/HOYS, BSHA, SHB(GB) BSPS, BSPA, Tattersalls RoR Open /Amateur Ridden Show Series Qualifier, TARRA Ridden, or any other open class **except** Tattersalls RoR Challenge Show Series, other Working Hunter type classes or RoR In Hand classes. Unaffiliated Show wins are not considered.

Horses may remain in the Tattersalls RoR Novice Ridden Show Series (Formerly RoR Jockey Club Novice Show Series) classes until they have won three Tattersalls RoR Novice Show Series Qualifiers. They are de-noviced on their third novice win or at midnight on the day they win an open class, whichever happens first. They are still eligible to compete in the Tattersalls RoR Novice Final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships.

COLOURED HORSE/PONY RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Ponies: Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn. Ponies under 153 cms.

Horses: Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Spurs may be worn by adult riders. Animals 153cms and over.

MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year and suitably mounted. Spurs must not be worn.

MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Fells, Dales, Highlands, New Forests, Connemara, Welsh C and Welsh D. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn.

LEAD REIN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

FIRST RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthdays but not attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

PLAITED PONY RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open plaited pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Any suitably mounted rider. Spurs must not be worn.

LEAD REIN PLAITED RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Lead Rein Pony mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders to have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

FIRST RIDDEN PLAITED AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders to have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

RIDDEN RIDING HORSE/HACK AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open to Hacks and Riding Horses. mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms but Hacks not exceeding 160cms. Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders.

RIDDEN COB AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. . Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders.

RIDDEN HUNTER AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. . Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders.

RIDDEN VETERAN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR

Open to horses and ponies of any breed, type and height, 15 years and over. Riders of any age, suitably mounted – animals will not be galloped. Spurs not to be worn. Blemishes are not taken into consideration.

The NPS/RINGSIDE STUD M&M Open Ridden National Championship

Class 1 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A, Welsh B

Class 2 Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C, Welsh D

Open to registered pure bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings five years old or over.

The NPS/ M&M Junior Ridden National Championship

Class 1 Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A & B mares and geldings four years old and over. Riders must not have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 2 Open to registered Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section C & D mares and geldings four years old and over. Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

The NPS/PARTRIDGE & PARR M&M First Ridden National Championship

Open to mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

NPS/LEEMAN FAMILY Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony Gold Medal Open Ridden National Championship

Class 1 – Show Ponies not exceeding 133cms

Class 2 – Show Hunter Ponies not exceeding 133cms

Class 3 – Show Ponies exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 148cms

Class 4 – Show Hunter Ponies exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 153cms

Class 5 – Intermediate Show Riding Type or Show Hunter Type, exceeding 148cm and not exceeding 158cm.

Optional If classes are amalgamated the highest placed pony from each height group will qualify. Riders may be any age. Rider to be a suitable size for the pony. Riders must be 12 years old or over when riding stallions not exceeding 128cm and 14 years old or over when riding stallions exceeding 128cms. The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition or to qualify but the owner must be a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final.

The NPS/FAULCONBRIDGE Part Bred Ridden National Championship

Stallions, mares and geldings, four years old and over. Classes as follows:

Class 1- Part Bred Arab. Horse/pony to be registered in the partbred or anglo arab section of the Arab Horse Society with a minimum of 12.5% Arab blood.

Class 2- Part Bred M&M. Horse/pony to be registered in the partbred section of one of the M&M studbooks with a minimum of 12.5% of that breed blood. Horses/ponies may be shown plaited or unplaited to suit type. Rider any age, except stallions (see rules in section A 3.2).

The NPS/FAULCONBRIDGE In Hand Part Bred National Championship

Horse or Pony of any age, excluding foals. Classes as follows:

Class 1- Part Bred Arab. Horse/pony to be registered in the partbred or anglo arab section of the Arab Horse Society with a minimum of 12.5% Arab blood.

Class 2- Part Bred M&M. Horse/pony to be registered in the partbred section of one of the M&M studbooks with a minimum of 12.5% of that breed blood. Horses/ponies may be shown plaited or unplaited to suit type. Handler any age except stallions (see rules in section A 3.2)

The NPS PUBS (Ponies of Unregistered Breeding) National Championship

Open to mares and geldings 148cm or under, 4 years old and over (for ridden classes) with no verified parentage. Must possess a basic ID passport. Rider any age. The owner does not have to be a NPS member for the pony to enter this competition, to qualify or to enter the final. Ponies to be judged as a practical family all round pony displaying good manners, correct way of going and functional conformation

Classes as follows:

Class 1- In Hand

Class 2 - Ridden

NPS/MR & MRS ROBERTS OTTERGAYLE Hack & Riding Horse In Hand Supreme Championship

Classes (to be defined by the affiliating show) including the following:

Class 1 Hacks four years old and over, stallions, mares and geldings.

Class 2 Hacks three years old and under, colts fillies and geldings

Class 3 Riding Horses four years old and over, stallions, mares and geldings.

Class 4 Riding Horses three years and under, colts, fillies and geldings.

The owner does not have to be an NPS member to enter the competition, to qualify, or to enter the Final. The first placed horse in each class will qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. Qualification may go no lower than third place. Foals are excluded from qualifying.

NPS/NIPNA DALES PONY STUD M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M Ridden section (excluding Leading Rein, First Ridden & WHP). Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification. A pony can only attend one M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship final in a season either at NPS Summer Championships at Malvern or at NPS Scotland Championships at Scone Palace. A pony may only take the qualification for the Silver Medal Final once in a season.



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We've teamed up with The Horse Trust and Top Spec for the 'Healthiest Body Awards'.

The Horse Trust created and piloted The Weigh To Win (#the weightowin) scheme in collaboration with the University of Liverpool back in 2019 in order to recognise and reward exhibitors in show classes with the healthiest equine body condition. The programme has been further developed to spread the word on how best to maintain healthy equine weight.

Watch our FB page for more info on the show date and classes in which these awards will take place. Judged by Top Spec who will have a weigh bridge on the showfield during this event, feeding advice will also be available.

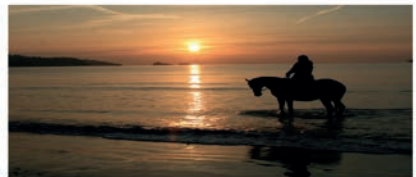

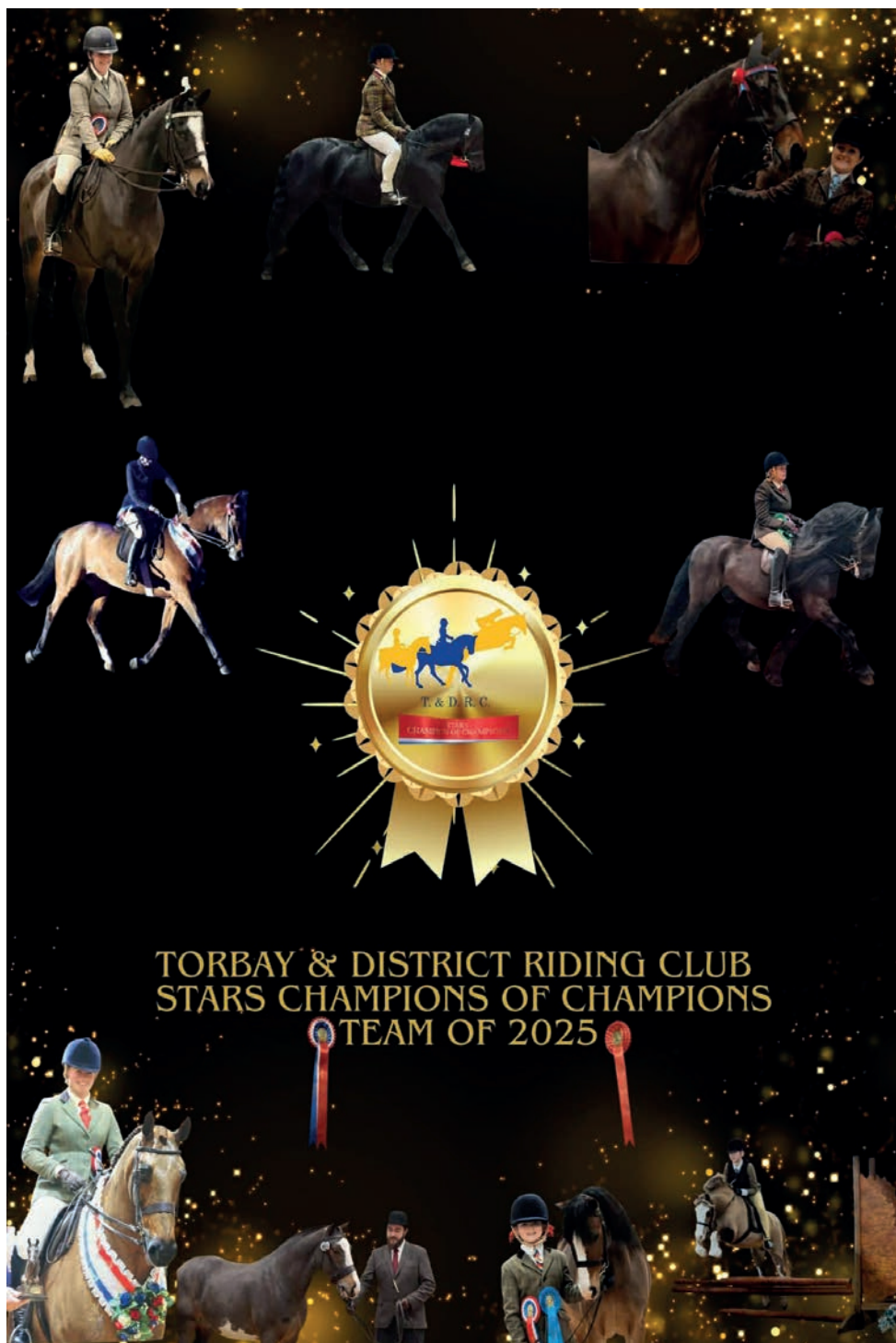

TDRC RULES FOR COMPETITORS & SPECTATORS

- All competitors and spectators shall hold the organisers TDRC and the landowners blameless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings ensuing from any kind of accident, loss or damage to horse/pony, rider, spectator, vehicle, dog or property.
- Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes and with a £10 deposit, refundable if objection upheld.
- The judges decision is final - any competitor or spectator arguing with a judge will be asked to leave the showground and will be banned from the club for the rest of the season.
- Anyone arguing or verbally abusive to any of our committee or show team will be asked to leave the showground.
- It is compulsory for any mounted persons under 18 yrs to wear a hard hat to current BS this rule also applies to under 12 yrs showing in hand. We strongly recommend that body protectors be worn when jumping.
- Any animal the committee deems to be in an unfit state will be asked to leave the showfield.
- No cantering or galloping outside the rings or in the lorry park
- No lunging in the lorry park
- Competitors **MUST** leave the ring at a walk.
- No warming up in showing rings, use warm up areas **ONLY**
- Stallions and Colts are permitted on the field by prior arrangement but on the understanding that you may be asked to leave by the committee if they are behaving in an unsuitable manner.
- All competitors must be correctly dressed for the classes they are in. Competitors will be banned for mistreatment of any animal, no refund will be given.
- All trophies from our presentation are held for one season and must be returned by the date posted on our FB at the end of the season. They must be returned in good clean condition with professional engraving only. Anyone returning trophies that breach this rule will not be allowed trophies in the future,
- All horses & ponies must have their annual vaccinations, passports may be spot checked.
- Any breach of the above rules will invalidate all entries for the remainder of the day, no refund will be given.
- By entering the showfield you are agreeing to these T&Cs. You are also accepting these T&Cs for anyone accompanying you to the event.
- ***In the event of the show being cancelled you will be offered to transfer your entries to our next event, if this is not possible a REFUND less any FEES will be made. There will be NO REFUNDS made if you are unable to attend the show. However a refund will be possible on production of a vet certificate issued for that horse/pony.***



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
